



Safeguarding Update

Hello Everyone

Harmful Sexual Behaviour is a big societal topic at the moment with the ongoing media coverage of the allegations being made against Prince Andrew and the speculation about whether and how he may stand trial for them.



It is also a big topic within education institutions, including further education ones like ATTFE. This has been the case ever since Ofsted and the Department for Education conducted research over the past couple of years that suggested that incidents of sexual harassment and even sexual violence in schools and colleges were much more frequent than anyone realised.

If you have any concerns about these areas, whether for yourself or another student, please talk to us or to the member of staff that you feel most comfortable with. We need and want to know so that we can deal with it. We will also be working with students on these topics including things like:

- Safe sexual behaviour and relationships
- Specific issues like sexting and sending/receiving pics
- Consent for and within relationships for sexual activity
- Issues connected to sexual harassment including verbal as well as physical.

If there is any way that you think we can improve our environment to reduce and eliminate sexual harassment in all its forms then please come forward and let us know - we want to hear and listen.
