

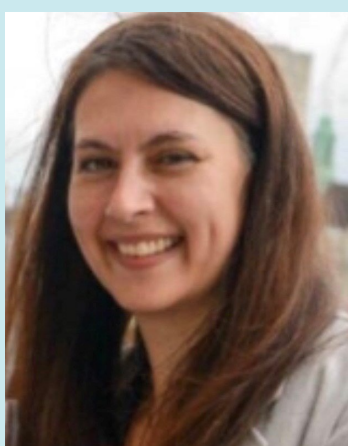

Safeguarding Update

Hello Everyone

The legal age for marriage in England and Wales has been raised from age 16 and is now 18. This applies to both male and female and means that it is now illegal for an adult over 18 to marry anyone under 18 of either sex. Two links about this are below, one to a news article about it, and the other to the international 'Girls not Brides' which has campaigned against under-age marriage across the world for years.

This is an important step in helping to protect young people from potentially being drawn into 'fixed' relationships with older adults where there may be power imbalances and the potential for abuse.

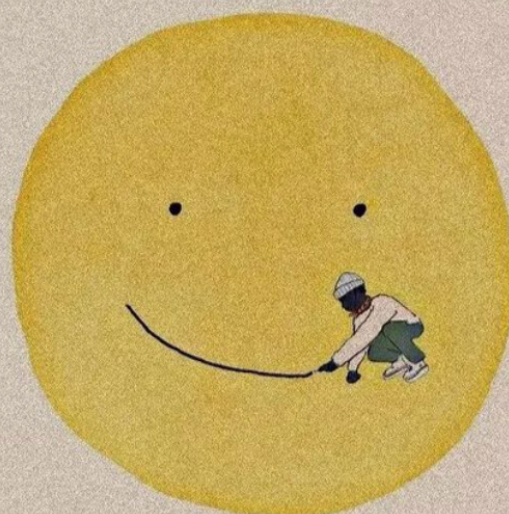
