You have probably heard in the media about the various security concerns surrounding the upcoming Coronation celebrations. These will obviously be in the public arena, in public spaces with many millions of people present, not just in London but at mass participation events around the country.

This gives further implications for the greatest perceived UK threat of attack at the moment which is known as 'self-initiated terrorism' (formerly known as 'lone wolf' or 'lone actor'), from all ends of the ideological extremist spectrum. The attached Briefing gives some further detail on this. We have shared information of this nature before but you may find it useful to have a look through, just to remind yourself of what to be aware of if you are about and about over the next few days.
