Easy Valentines Recipe



Chocolate-Dipped Strawberries

Preparation time: 20 mins

Cooking time: 4 mins

Serves: 5 servings

Indulge in chocolate-dipped strawberries for

dessert or as part of a romantic picnic. Drizzle over milk and white chocolate for the wow factor!

Recipe by Liberty Mendez (Source: Good Food)

Ingredients

- 100g dark chocolate (roughly chopped)
- 400g strawberries
- 30g white and milk chocolate (roughy chopped), optional

Method

- 1. Cut a strip of baking parchment and leave to one side. To melt the dark chocolate, fill a small pan with 2cm water and bring to a simmer. Put the chocolate in a heatproof bowl and rest it on top of the pan, ensuring the bowl isn't touching the water. Stir the chocolate to gradually melt it. Or, melt the chocolate in 20 second blasts in the microwave, stirring after each blast until melted. Put the melted chocolate in a small deep bowl.
- 2. Gently hold the strawberries by the leafy top and dip into the chocolate. Tap off any excess chocolate and put on the parchment to set. If you have any leftover chocolate, pour it onto another strip of parchment and leave it to set, it can be used again.
- 3. If you'd like to decorate the strawberries, melt the white and milk chocolate and drizzle lightly over the fruit.

Have fun, and enjoy your sweet treat!

Materials:

- Red, green, white and black paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Circle Punch (optional)

Steps:

1. Start by cutting out a large red heart, 3 smaller green hearts and a few tiny white hearts. Glue all the hearts together and add a stem.

2. You could also add a little character to you strawberry by gluing on a sweet face. We love punching out circles for our eyes, but googly eyes would look great too.



Our weekly food pantries provide low cost food for families whilst reducing food waste. See below details to find out where your local food pantry is. There is no need to book and no referral needed.


Good quality high value food bags (please bring your own bag) available on a weekly basis. For £3.50 payments each week you will receive between £12-£15 worth of good quality food.
