Hello Everyone,

You will be aware from the extensive media coverage about the knife attack and death at a school in Sheffield.

There are some simple but effective processes for us to adhere to that will go a long way towards keeping us safe.

1. All of our premises are protected by SWIPE lanyard systems. This prevents anyone unauthorised from being able to get in. However, it rests upon students wearing their lanyards for identification, authorisation and access.

Please make sure you have your lanyards with you and on display at all times.

2. Lost or mislaid lanyards must be immediately reported.

3. You must not under any circumstances swap or exchange lanyards – to do so opens individuals to considerable risk and vulnerability.

4. You should not under any circumstances admit people into ATTFE or ATT/academy premises/buildings if you do not know or recognise them as authorised to be there – e.g., a current staff member or student.

5. Everyone needs to be aware of "tailgating" and immediately shutting doors/gates behind them. It is fine to tell people that they cannot just follow you in and that they need to go through the proper identification/admission process as appropriate.

6. Anyone/anything arousing suspicion in and around our buildings and our learners needs to be immediately reported as a matter of emergency.

7. Please remember that you can talk to staff if you feel worried, anxious, vulnerable or unsafe, whether in "College time" or out of "College time".

The power of checking for understanding!

Hello everyone,

Well done for all your hard work this term, you should be proud of your achievements and enjoy your break ready to return for Spring term 2.



As we move into next term, one key focus in your learning journey with us will be checking for understanding, which is a vital part of how we learn, grow, and succeed. This is more than just answering questions.... it's about making sure you truly grasp, retain, and apply the knowledge you're gaining.

Why does this matter?

- Identify Learning gaps, to spot and address any misunderstandings early on.
- Boost confidence & independence, to feel more assured in your knowledge and take ownership of your learning.
- Engage & think critically, by being active in lessons, contribute ideas, and develop problem-solving skills.
- Improve memory & retention, to strengthen recall of knowledge through discussions, quizzes, and practical application.
- Prepare for Success Gain the skills to apply what you learn beyond the classroom.

How might we check for understanding?

- 1. Group/ pairing activities such as, Think-Pair-Share, to discuss ideas with a partner before sharing with the group.
- 2. Quick quizzes to reflect on key takeaways from each session.
- 3. Traffic light system, use red, amber and green to self-assess your confidence in a topic.
- 4. Class discussions & questioning, to explore ideas deeply through guided conversations.

These approaches help ensure that everyone is on track, understands key concepts, and is fully prepared for assessments and real-world applications. Remember, asking questions and seeking clarification is a strength, not a setback!


